

Embedding a YouTube Video in your Blackboard Course

1. On the YouTube video page, copy the embed code which can be found to the right of the video. Example:

2. In your Blackboard course, click on the Control Panel.
3. Select the Content Area where you want your video to be seen, such as Course Documents.
4. From that page, select Add Item.
5. **1 - Content Information** - In the Subject field, type in the name of the video.
6. In the Message field, paste the code from YouTube.
7. Select the HTML button underneath the Message field. *
8. **3 - Options** (Optional) - Restrict when the video would be available by choosing date and time restrictions.
9. **4 - Submit** - Click Submit.

* If there is no HTML button, then click on the My UofL tab. Under Tools, click Personal Information. Under Personal Information, click Set Visual Text Box Editor Options. Under 1 - Manage Visual Text Box Editor, click Unavailable. Click Submit. Click OK. Click on the My UofL tab and return to your course and start over. (You will not have to repeat this step again.)
